As of **11th December 2020** there are no restrictions for teams and officials travelling into Poland for international sport events (no PCR, nor quarantine required) provided that entering individuals are able to prove the fact of the event being held and that they are officially entered as participating athletes/team officials, judges, accredited journalists.
